
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The vast majority of the patchy snowpack will be well bonded and stable. Localised accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will persist in wind sheltered locations on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Deepest accumulations will be encountered in gully tops and around steep corrie rims above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light precipitation, falling as snow above 700 metres, will soon ease to give mostly dry conditions. Winds will be moderate, occasionally fresh, West-South-Westerly. The freezing level will slowly rise from 650 to 800 metres.
