

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to develop. Greatest accumulations will be on North to East aspects above 900 metres. North-West and South-East aspects will also be affected. Fragile cornices will build above these aspects. Other aspects will be scoured and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong West-South-West winds will ease for a time in the early morning, then back Southerly and become strong again during the day. Showers in the evening and during the day falling as snow above around 700 metres. The freezing level will be around 800 metres, rising briefly to 1000 metres in the morning.
