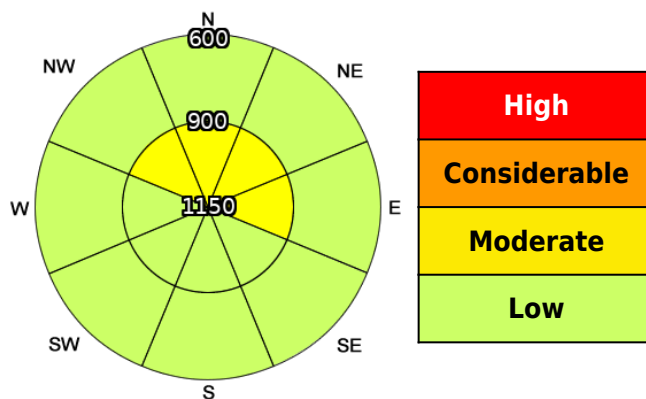

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab will continue to form in wind sheltered locations on mainly North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Steeper locations such as gully tops and sharply defined corrie rims will be worst affected. Cornices will be fragile. Elsewhere the snow will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snowfall during the day above 750 metres. Light, increasing to moderate, generally Southerly winds. Freezing level 700 to 800 metres.

Comments

Rapid shift from stable to unstable terrain - both can be encountered in close proximity to each other. Old snow ice is firm and icy.
