




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities within windslab will persist in the cold temperatures. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. Some more localised instabilities mainly in gullies on North aspects. Fragile cornices above all these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some very light showers will be snow at all levels. Winds will be moderate Westerly. The freezing level will be around 200 metres.

Comments

Remaining cold on Tuesday, instabilities in snowpack likely to persist.
