

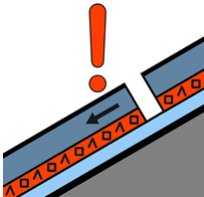

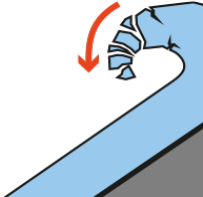

Wind Slab



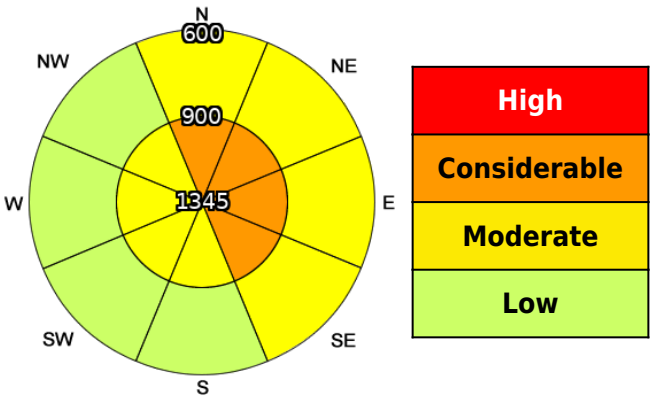
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The cold conditions will maintain instabilities and so little change is expected in the snowpack. Deposits of windslab of varying degrees of stability, some of it poorly bonded, will remain in wind-sheltered locations such as gullies and coire rims on many aspects above 900 metres. Most affected will be North through East to South-East aspects. Some substantial fragile cornices will exist above these aspects. Below 900 metres stability will be better. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be cold and generally dry. Temperatures will be below freezing at all but the lowest levels. Moderate winds will be from the West.
