




Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will cause instabilities in the snowpack to persist. Windslab will remain poorly bonded in many locations, with greatest accumulations on steep North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. More localised instabilities exist on North and South aspects with gullies particularly affected. Fragile cornices will remain present above all these aspects. Better stability on slopes scoured by the recent Westerly winds. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

A dry cold day with light to moderate Westerly winds. It will be freezing at most levels.
