

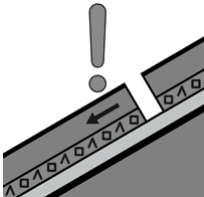

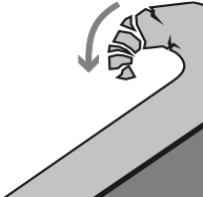
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



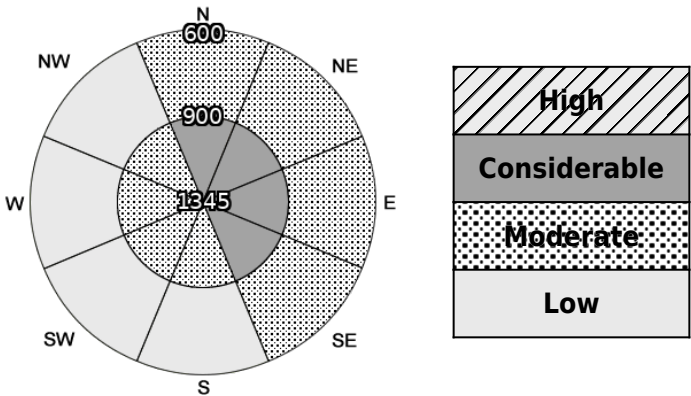
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The cold conditions will maintain weaknesses within the snowpack. Areas of unstable windslab will remain above 900 metres in wind sheltered locations on mainly, but not exclusively, North through East to South-East facing slopes and gullies. Some large fragile cornices will exist above these aspects. Below 900 metres stability will be better. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The cold and settled conditions will continue. Although a few light snow showers are possible it will remain generally dry throughout. Moderate winds will be from the West. The freezing level will be around 200 metres.
