




##### Avalanche Problems




Persistent Weak Layers

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will persist in wind sheltered locations on North-East through East to South aspects above 850 metres. Deepest accumulations will be encountered in wind sheltered scarp slopes, gully tops and around corrie rims. Isolated deep deposits will also be found on other aspects and at lower levels. Any exposed slope will be firm and icy. Cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be a dry day. Remaining cold, freezing at all levels. Fresh winds throughout, mostly North-West.

##### Comments

Likely to be another very cold day on the hills.
