


Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh, unstable but generally shallow windslab will be present mainly on North through East to South aspects above 900 metres. Deeper instabilities will also persist in older windslab on many aspects with North through East to South-East aspects most affected. Large and fragile cornices will be present mainly above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong North-West winds back South-West overnight and veer Westerly during the day. Snow showers. The freezing level will rise to around 400 metres during the day.

Remaining cold for Thursday and Friday with warmer conditions forecast for the weekend.
