

Wind Slab





Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities in both recent and older accumulations of windslab will persist. These will mainly be found on North through East to South aspects above 900 metres. Large and fragile cornices will be present mainly above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A ridge of high pressure will bring dry conditions. Fresh Northerly winds in the evening will veer to the South-East and become mainly light during the day. After an overnight frost the freezing level will rise to around 600 metres.

Comments

A good day forecast for Friday then all change at the weekend with strong South-West winds, light rain, and the freezing level rising above the summits.
