



##### Avalanche Problems





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will start to thaw at all levels during the day. Poorest stability will be found on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Steep wind sheltered locations such as gully tops, scarp slopes and crag aprons will be most affected. Many of these areas will have unstable large cornices above them. Isolated wet snow instabilities are also possible in steep lee locations at lower levels. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming milder with the freezing level rising above all summits during the day. Any snowfall will be very light. Southerly winds expected to become strong during the day.

##### Comments

Thaw conditions will arrive Saturday. Snowpack expected to destabilise. Careful route choice advised.
