



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will slowly consolidate in the mild conditions. Instabilities will persist in deeper accumulations of windslab and wet snow surface instabilities will be present. North through East to South aspects above 800 metres will be most affected. Cornices, mainly to be found above these aspects, will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force Southerly winds will ease through the day. Showers will generally fall as rain with snow possible only on the highest summits. The freezing level will be above the summits.

Comments

Cornices are prone to collapse and may trigger avalanches.
