

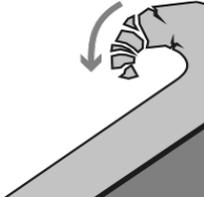



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly consolidate in the mild conditions. Wet snow instabilities will be present mainly on steep North through East to South aspects above 900 metres. On other aspects and at lower elevations the snowpack will be generally stable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mainly dry with some light drizzle possible. Fresh Southerly winds and a freezing level above the summits.

Comments

Mild on Monday and Tuesday with a cold front forecast for Wednesday.
