

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and slowly consolidate becoming mostly well bonded and stable. A few localised areas of moderately bonded snow will persist in the deeper accumulations which will be encountered in steeper, wind sheltered locations on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 1000 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation has been forecast. Winds, light Southerly overnight, becoming moderate South-South-Westerly by day. Freezing level well over all summits.

Comments

Mild on Monday and Tuesday. Cooler conditions returning on Wednesday.
