

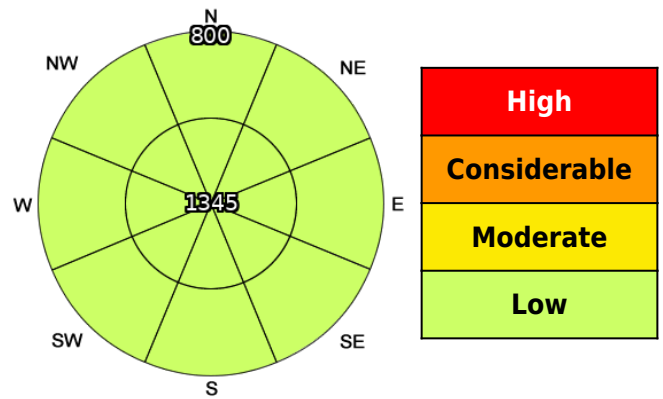

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 27/01/2023**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The existing snowpack will remain firm, icy and stable. The most significant snowfields being found on North through to East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It is forecast to be clear overnight and cloudy and dry throughout the day. Freezing level will be around 700m and slowly rise to around the summits by the end of the day. Overnight, winds will be light and back to a Southerly direction. During the day the South-South-Westerly winds will slowly increase from moderate to fresh.

**Comments**

Hard and icy underfoot. Serious travel conditions with slip and run-out consequences. Ice axe and crampons essential.
