

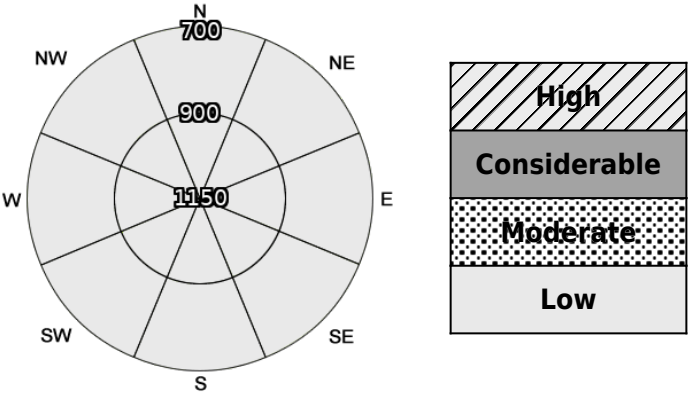
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 29/01/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in all locations. Fresh snow amounts in the afternoon are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

West-South-Westerly winds will increase to reach gale force during the day. Dry overnight with rain during the day turning to snow through the afternoon. The freezing level will rise above the summits during the day and drop to around 800 metres at the end of the period.
