



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 29/01/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain stable, hard and well bonded on all aspects. Any fresh accumulations will be shallow and not significant. Remaining cornices will weaken and be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snow turning to rain at all levels during the day. It will be drier by dusk. Freezing levels will rise above the summits early in the morning and remain there throughout the day, then drop back down to around 700 metres by evening. Very strong South-Westerly winds will increase to gale force during the day, then veer to Westerlies.

Comments

Another temperature cycle tomorrow, then another is forecast early next week. Not great for the skiing, but good for the climbing. Ice axe and crampons essential for safe travel on snow slopes.
