



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The main snowpack will be found on North to East aspects above 800 metres. At higher levels it will remain hard and icy. At lower levels it will gently thaw. In both cases stability will remain good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be generally dry with the freezing level around the summits. Strong winds will be from the South.

Snowpack hard and icy, significant slip hazard at the moment.
