

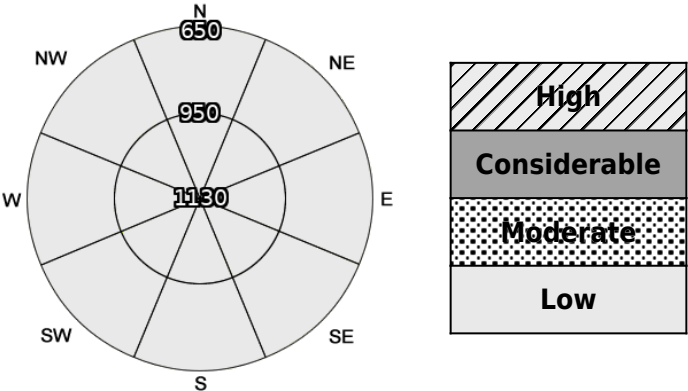

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 08/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good snowpack stability, becoming firm overnight and softening at lower elevations during the day. Fresh snow amounts in the afternoon are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry until late afternoon when precipitation will fall as snow above around 800 metres. Winds will increase overnight to become gale force South-South-Westerly during the day. After an overnight frost the freezing level will be around 900 metres during the day.

Comments

Best snow cover on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres.
