

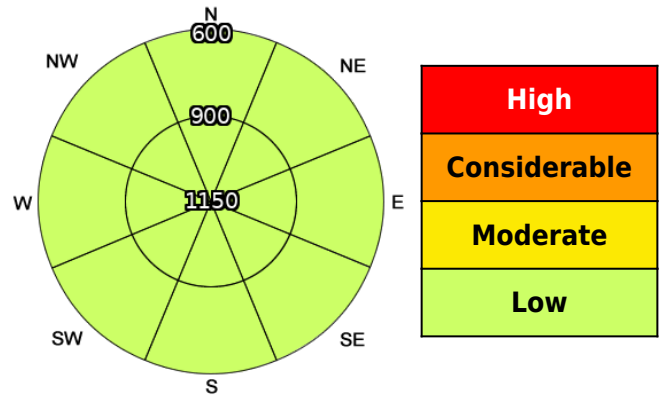
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 09/02/2023

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining patchy snow will be firm, well bonded and stable. Shallow accumulations of fresh snow will be present in wind sheltered locations on North-East to South-East aspects but deposits will not achieve any significant depth. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Very light snowfall during the evening followed by a mostly dry day. Strong, generally Westerly winds throughout. 500 metre freezing level overnight, rising steadily to 800 metres by the afternoon.

#### Comments

Old snow firming up again in the cooler temperatures.
