

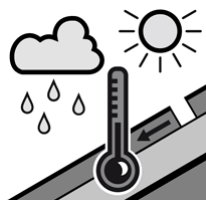

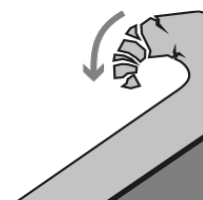

Wind Slab



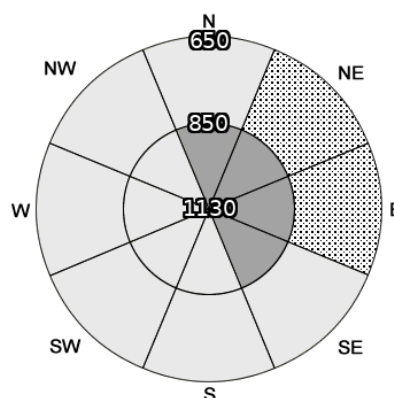
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Period of poorest stability when snowfall transitions to rain and milder temperatures at all levels. Weak, collapse prone cornices above most steep lee slopes. Improvement in overall stability anticipated later in the day. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light overnight snowfall turning to rain at all levels from morning onwards. Moderate to strong West-South-West winds. Initially cold, but much milder from early hours onwards.

Comments

Friday looking wet! Better stability is anticipated later in the day. Weak wet cornices.
