

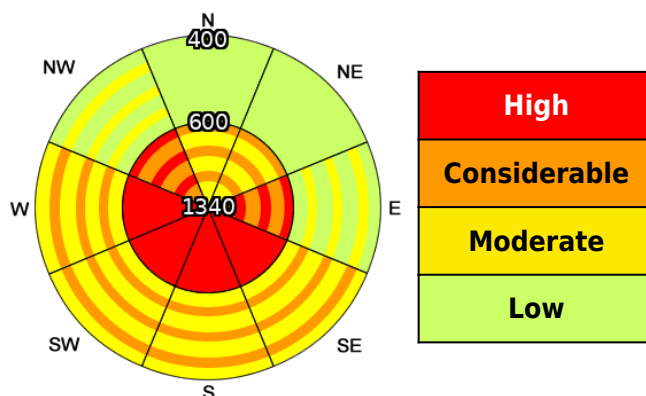

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 10/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Any new snow will be shallow and inconsequential. Older snow will remain firm and well bonded. Greatest amounts will be found in North to East corries above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 950 metres overnight, lifting above the summits early morning. Light precipitation with both snow and rain expected. Winds, generally South-West overnight, veering to the West and strengthening to gale force by afternoon.

Comments

Likely to be another windy day. Old snow is very firm and icy.
