

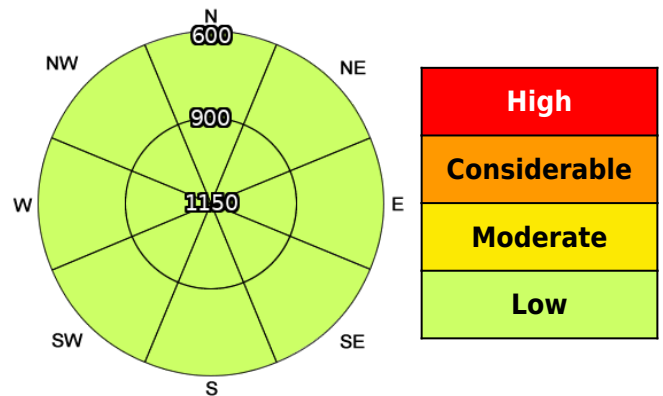

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 11/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow will be slowly thawing at all levels but will be well consolidated and stable in all locations. Greatest snow cover will be on North to East facing coires above 900m, with only small snow patches remaining below this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a predominantly dry day with the freezing level remaining above the summits. Westerly winds will ease from fresh to moderate strength in the early hours.

Comments

A relatively calm weekend ahead, but with freezing levels above the summits. Despite the thaw, some icy patches will remain on hillsides and paths.
