

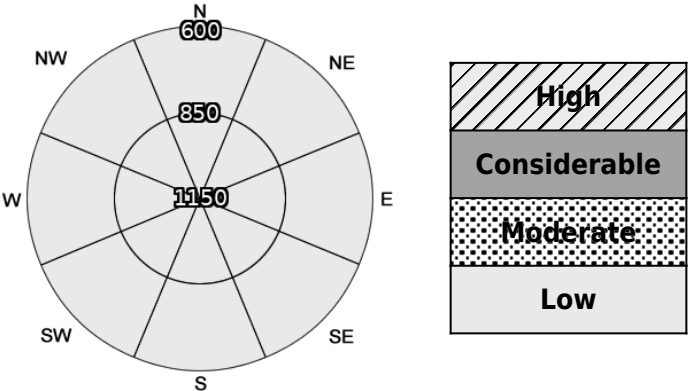

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 11/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snowpack will continue to consolidate in the drier conditions. Snowpack stability will be good in all locations. The snow cover will continue to gradually diminish with greatest accumulations remaining in North to East facing Corries and Gullies above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain during the early part of the night will clear to give a dry day. The freezing level will be just above the highest summits. Winds will be strong West-South-Westerly.
