

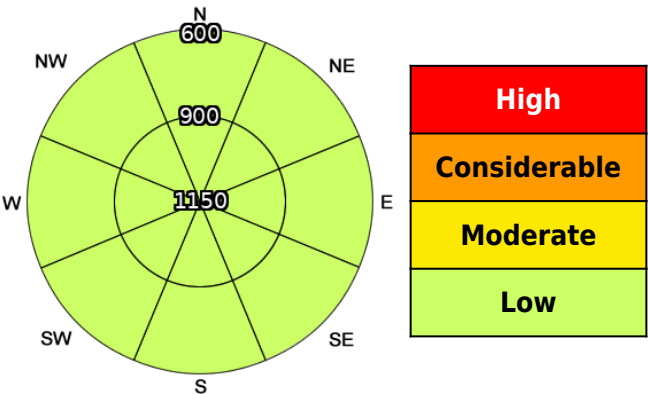

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 12/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in the mild conditions. Snowpack stability will be generally good. The greatest snow accumulations will be on North to East aspects above 900 metres, with small snow patches below this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a dry and mild day with no precipitation expected. The freezing level will remain above the highest summits and the winds will be strong South-Westerlies.

Comments

The mild and dry conditions continue. Despite the thaw some snow patches remain firm with consequential runouts.
