



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 13/02/2023**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected. The snowpack will be generally stable at all levels. Its surface will be frozen above around 1000 metres. Greatest accumulations of snow will remain on North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It is expected to be dry throughout the period, with summit air temperatures below zero. Winds will be moderate generally Southerly.

There are areas of ice on the plateaux.
