

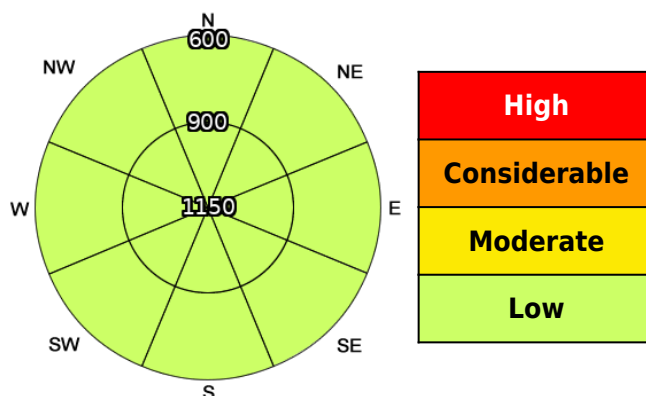

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow will continue to thaw but will be well bonded and stable throughout. Greatest amounts will be found in North to East facing corries above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day is expected with the freezing level above the summits. Moderate to fresh winds from the South.

Comments

Old snow will be very firm and icy, particularly in shaded locations.
