

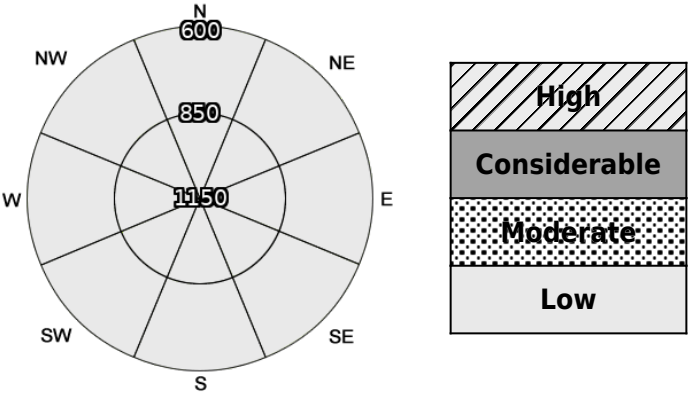

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remaining frozen overnight at higher altitudes and be well consolidated and stable. The snowpack will slowly soften in the wetter and milder conditions. No new snow expected, the largest accumulations remain on North to East aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will be around 1000 metres rising above the summits from dawn. It will be mainly dry and cloudy with a period of rain during the morning. Southerly winds throughout, increase fresh to strong during the day.
