

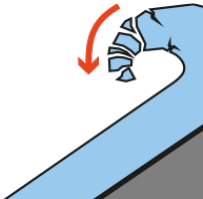

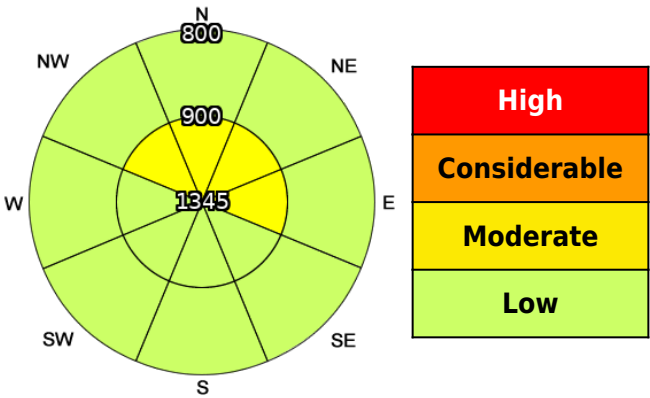
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of unstable windslab will develop during the day mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Features such as gullies, corrie rims and ridge flanks will be particularly affected. Fragile cornices will form above these aspects. The older snowpack will be firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a mainly dry night precipitation during the day will fall as snow above around 800 metres. Southerly gales overnight veer and ease to become strong South-Westerlies during the day. Freezing level dropping from above the summits to around 900 metres during the day.
