

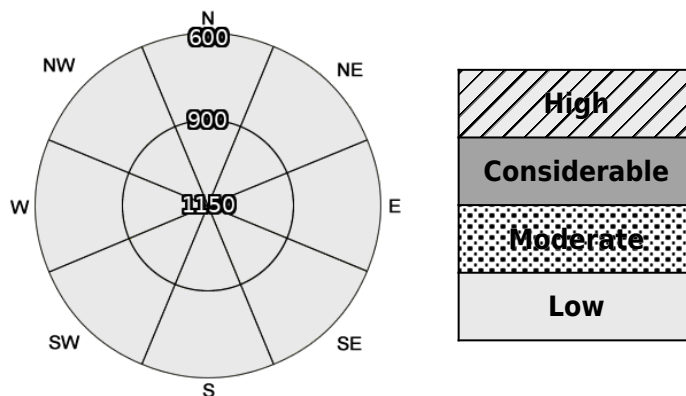

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 18/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining older snow will be firm and well bonded. There will be a shallow covering of new fresh snow on most aspects above 700 metres or so. New accumulations will not achieve any significant depth with much of this falling onto bare ground. Largest areas of snow will be found on North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A colder period with the freezing level around 700 metres. There will be snowfall overnight, dry during the day. Winds will be variable throughout this period but North-East by dawn veering South-East by the end of the day. Moderate in strength overnight, easing from dawn.
