
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally stable overnight. During the day isolated wet snow instabilities will develop mainly on steep North to East aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a dry night with moderate winds and a freezing level around 800 metres. During the day South-West winds will gradually increase to gale force, precipitation will fall as snow on the highest summits in the morning, before turning to rain at all levels as the temperature rises above the summits in the afternoon.
