

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/02/2023


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw, consolidate and diminish. Snowpack stability will be good. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Greatest accumulations will remain in North to East facing corries and gullies above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Showers throughout the day will be rain at all levels. The freezing level will be above the summits. Gale force West-South-Westerly winds overnight will gradually ease to become strong by the end of the afternoon.

Comments

Thaw conditions continuing with icefall, rockfall and cornice collapse a potential hazard.
