

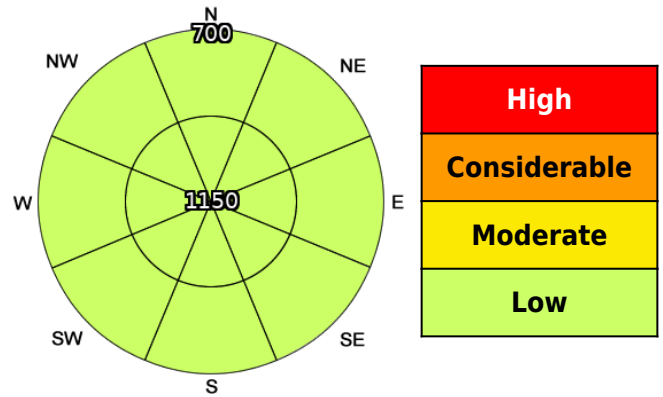

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate and will be generally stable. Greatest snow cover will remain on North to East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Storm force West-South-West winds initially, gradually easing to become very strong by late afternoon. Dry in the evening with precipitation starting during the night and falling as rain at all levels. The freezing level will be well above the summits.
