

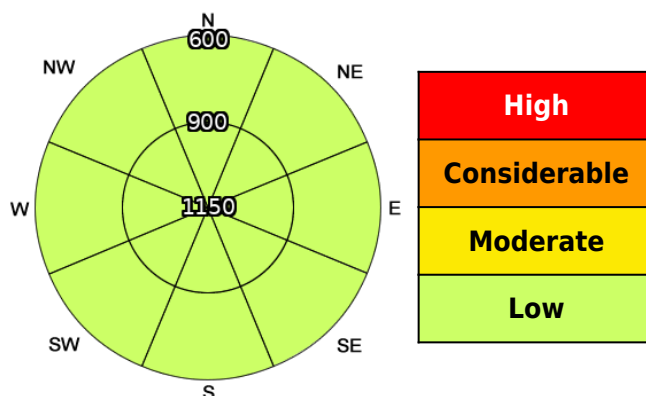

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow cover will continue to thaw but remain well bonded and demonstrate good stability throughout. Greatest snow cover will be found in North to East facing corries above 900 metres. Patchy elsewhere. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing mild with the freezing level above the summits. Other than overnight drizzle it will be dry. A moderate to fresh breeze is expected, generally South-Westerly during the day.
