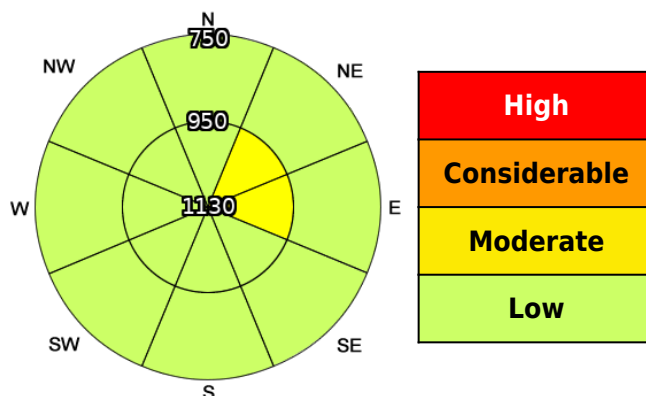
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in most places during early morning. Some redistribution of snow expected as wind speeds increase later. Localised accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will build on steep North-East to East aspects above 950m by the end of the day. Gully tops and coire rims the most affected locations. Better stability at lower altitudes and where recently wind scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry, cold and clear overnight with light winds. Some snow showers later in the morning on strengthening West-South-Westerly winds. Freezing level rising steadily to above summits by dusk.
