



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally stable with a breakable crust on recent accumulations and older snow very firm. Greatest accumulations are to be found on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with fresh to strong North-Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.
