

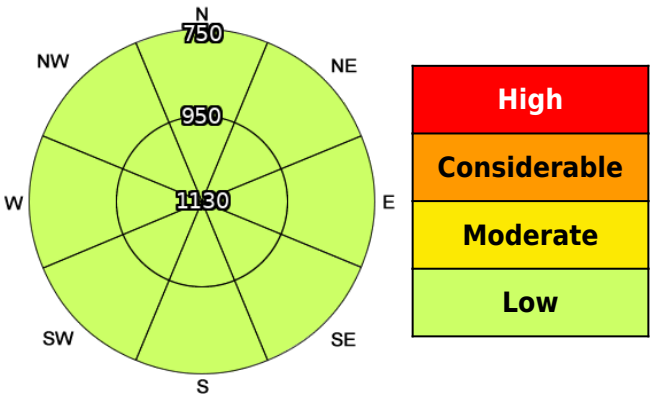

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 25/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Shallow recently deposited windslab will be present, mainly on East through South to South-West aspects above 950 metres. Accumulations having gained depth will not be extensive. The old snowpack, lying mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres, will generally be stable and its surface frozen. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the period, with moderate North-North-East winds. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.
