

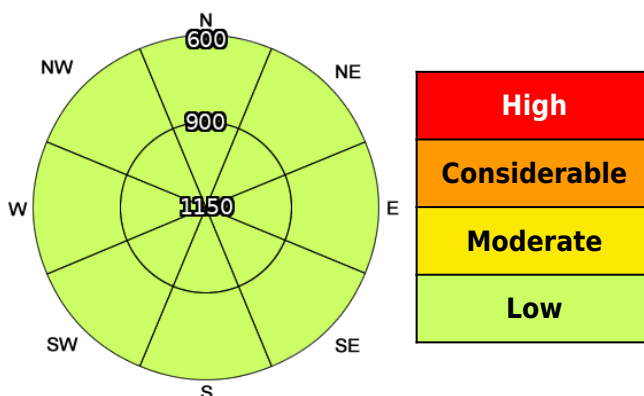

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 25/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow cover will be well bonded in all locations. Greatest coverage, which will be found in North to East facing corries above 900 metres will be very firm and icy with isolated pockets of softer snow persisting on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain dry with the freezing level around 600 metres. Strong winds throughout, Northerly during the morning veering to the North-North-East in the afternoon.

Comments

Old snow is very firm and icy. Slips and trips are potentially serious.
