



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older snowpack will remain firm and stable. A shallow more recent layer of snow, mainly to be found on North-East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres, will have a minor weakness below a crust. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry and clear with light variable winds. After an overnight frost the freezing level will be around 600 metres during the day.

Comments

Dry settled conditions continuing for the next few days.
