



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old patchy snow will remain firm and well bonded. Localised pockets of softer snow will be encountered in wind sheltered locations on South-East and South aspects above 900 metres. Distribution will be limited and any accumulations will be mostly avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day with some sunshine and light, generally Easterly winds. Temperature inversion conditions but the summit air temperatures should just stay below freezing in the shade.
