

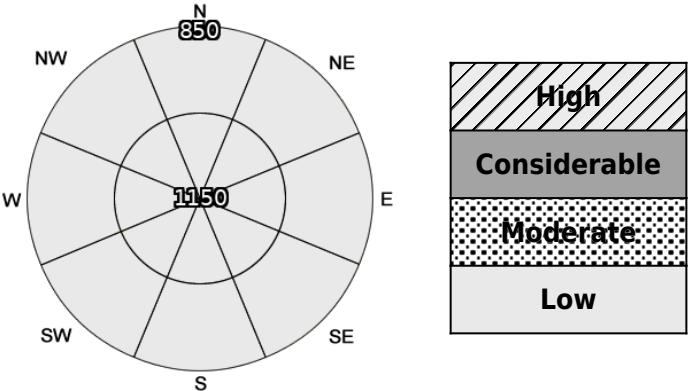

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 28/02/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The snowpack which mainly exists in the higher North and East facing corries will remain well bonded and stable. The surface is expected to refreeze and become firm overnight, softening where it receives some sun during the day. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with light variable winds. Cold overnight and warming during the day but freezing level poorly defined due to a temperature inversion.

Comments

Dry settled conditions are forecast to continue for the next few days.
