



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 01/03/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The snow cover will remain very limited. Snow patches will be very firm and icy with largest areas on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres, mostly in gullies and around coire rims. Mainly bare ground elsewhere. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry, cloudy day with light to moderate North-Easterly winds. Cold overnight and warming during the day but freezing level poorly defined due to a temperature inversion.
