

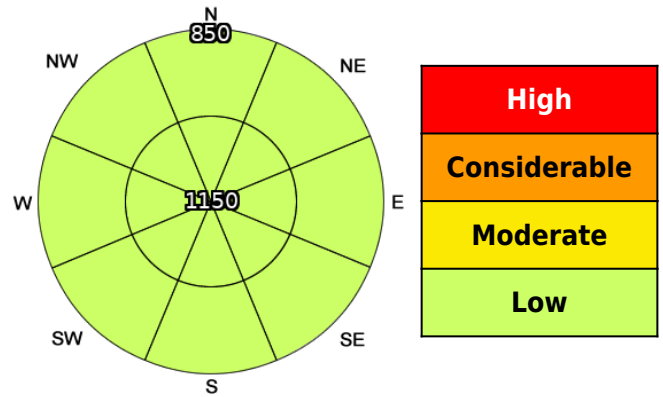

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 02/03/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The snowpack, which exists mainly in the higher North and East facing corries will remain well bonded and stable. The snow surface will be very firm and icy in most locations, only softening slightly where exposed to the sun. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A cold, dry day with some clouds and light, mainly Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 750 metres.

Comments

Settled conditions continuing. Snowpack is very firm with run-outs onto rock below many steep slopes: Any slip is likely to have serious consequences.
