

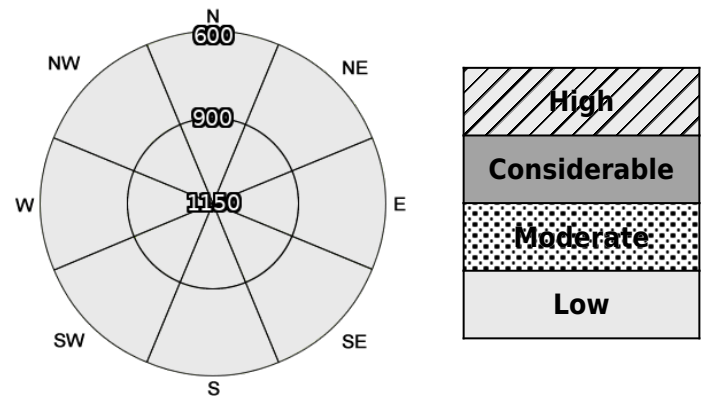

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 02/03/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow will be firm, well bonded and stable throughout. Largest areas of snow will be encountered on the high plateau areas of the main Cairngorms and on North to East aspects above 900 metres elsewhere. Localised softer accumulations will occasionally be found above 900 metres on South-East to South-West aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Another dry but cloudy day is expected. Moderate North-Easterly winds. Temperature inversion conditions but Munros are likely to remain below freezing at summit level.

Comments

High pressure remains into the weekend. Much colder weather expected early next week.
