



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 04/03/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain stable, firm and icy on North to East aspects above 900 metres, while softer snow will remain on South-East to South-West aspects. Light snow will fall on the northern periphery of our area, although accumulations will be insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A mostly dry day is expected with light snow showers above 800 metres on the northern periphery of our area. Winds will be moderate and from the North overnight backing to the North-North-West by dawn. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.
