




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Soft, weak windslab will be more extensive on steep East to South aspects above 950 metres with new fragile cornice development anticipated. Better stability at lower elevations, on less steep ground and wherever the old mature snow is exposed and scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to fresh Northerly, later North Westerly winds. Only occasional light snow showers are forecast. Very cold temperatures.

Comments

More windslab but only near top of scarp slopes and gully exits. Weak fragile new cornices over recent lee slopes.
