




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of moderately bonded windslab will continue to develop, with East through South to West aspects now affected above 900 metres. Steep wind sheltered locations such as gully tops and corrie rims will be worst affected. Elsewhere, exposed terrain will remain very firm and icy. Isolated pockets of deeper snow will also be found at lower levels. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.





Forecast Weather Influences

Will be dry throughout, remaining cold in the glens. Winds, moderate in strength, North-East to North overnight, backing North-North-West, then North-West.
