

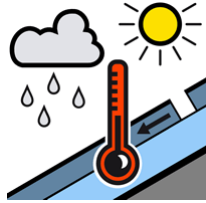

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 12/03/2023

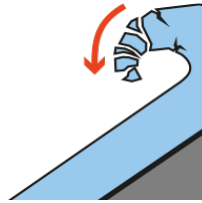
#### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



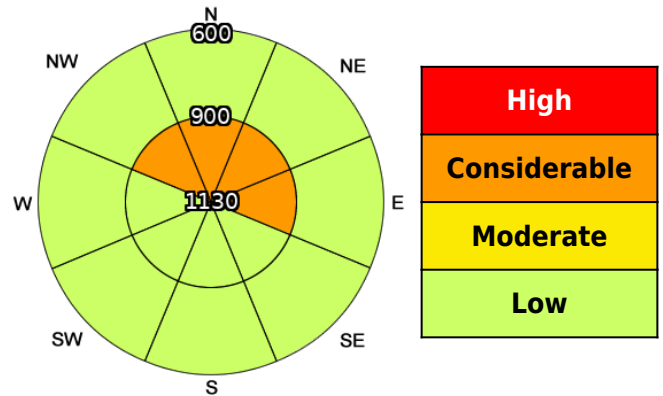
Wet Snow

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor stability on steep North-West through North to East aspects above 900m. New windslab, underlain by weak cold-induced layers, will gain depth at gully exits and the top of steep coire backwalls. Early new cornice development anticipated over steeper lee slopes. Better stability at lower elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh South-East winds becoming strong South-Westerly during the day. Snow showers throughout, turning to rain at lower levels from mid-morning. Cold overnight then a progressive rise in freezing level to above summit level by early afternoon.

#### Comments

Less alpine-like on Sunday! Period of poorest stability expected to be when the freezing level rises above summits in the afternoon.
