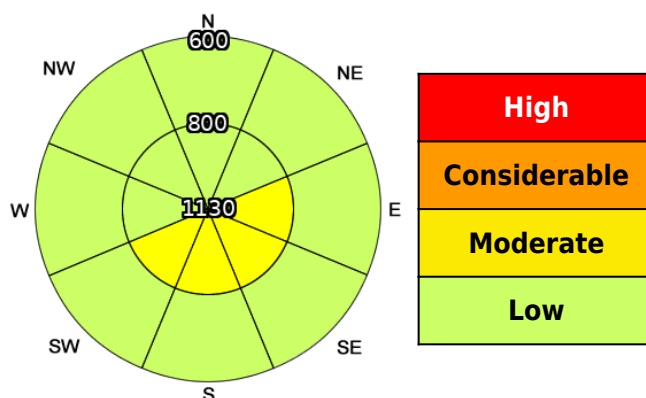

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weak windslab will be present on steep East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Most affected locations will be gully exits and the top of steep coire backwalls. New cornice development expected over steeper lee slopes. Better stability on ridges and recently wind-scoured locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light sporadic snow showers, otherwise dry. Very cold throughout. Strong North-East winds easing overnight and becoming light to moderate Westerly, later North-Westerly.

Comments

Very cold temperatures in prospect over the forecast period.
