



#### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution of snow is anticipated. New weak windslab will begin to gain depth on steep North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres during the course of the morning. More extensive windslab on North-West to North aspects much later. Weak new cornice development also expected over steepest lee slopes. Better stability on less steep ground, at lower altitudes, and where recently wind-scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Some late snow showers otherwise dry. Remaining very cold. Moderate North-West winds backing to fresh South-Easterly by late afternoon.

#### Comments

Location of avalanche hazard will change during the day as the wind shifts through 180 degrees from morning to afternoon.
